General Definitions per the PREA Resource Center:

<u>Substantiated Allegation</u>: An allegation that was investigated and determined to have occurred. <u>Unfounded Allegation</u>: An allegation that was investigated and determined not to have occurred.

<u>Unsubstantiated Allegation</u>: An allegation that was investigated and the investigation produced insufficient evidence to make a final determination as to whether or not the event occurred.

Community Transition Center is required to adhere to the PREA Standards for Community Confinement Agencies. Our agency has a Zero Tolerance policy toward Sexual Abuse and Sexual Harassment. Staff receives on going PREA training, in order to recognize, report, and prevent Sexual Abuse and/or Harassment among both staff and clients.

Clients are given a handbook at intake informing them of their rights and how to report any incidents of Sexual Abuse, Sexual Harassment, and/or Retaliation by either internal or external reporting.

Administrative staff will at a minimum once annually, review policies, procedures, and security measures, in order to ensure that both clients and staff have a safe housing and work environment. Any recommendations for change will be documented in meeting minutes and implemented as feasible.

All incidents involving PREA allegations and/or standards will be reviewed by Administrative staff and accommodations to prevent and/or minimize risk for sexual assault, sexual abuse, sexual harassment, and/or retaliation will be adhered to within the scope of Community Transition Center's capabilities.
